## And more and more cities... are choking like Delhi. some are even worse.

Out of the 70 cities monitored by the Central Pollution Control Board in 1997, only one – Shillong – had its pollution under control.

In all other cities air quality was moderately, highly or critically polluted through the year.

In the 1970s Japan faced a similar problem. So they put in 25% of industrial investment into pollution control. India has just begun to industrialise and motorise.

Can we afford the same measures?

If dirty vehicles are a problem, we must wake up. Now.
