DONE

- Elimination of leaded petrol by September 1, 1998
- Phasing out of 15-year-old commercial vehicles by December 31, 1998
- Supply of premix petrol for two-wheelers by December 31, 1998

NOT DONE

- Central Pollution Control Board to strengthen monitoring of pollutants by April 1, 2000... not done.
 Passing the buck.
- Conversion of all buses to CNG by March 31, 2000...
 tremendous resistance. Government may not meet deadline
- Setting up of two fuel testing laboratories by June 1999.
 Squabbling about who will pay.
- Gas Authority of India Ltd to set up 80 CNG dispensing stations by March 31, 2000...Being done. Currently
 12 stations. By March 80 stations should be ready.
 Tremendous resistance.
- Replacement of all pre-1990 autos and taxis with new vehicles on clean fuel by March 31, 2000. No interest in implementing order. Owners not informed.
- Financial incentives for replacement of all post 1990 autos and taxis with new vehicles running on clean fuels by March 31, 2001. **Almost no action**
- New ISBTs to be built at entry points by March 31, 2000...delays..almost dead.
