• Nov 1, 1996, CSE launched its Right to Clean Air campaign to build pressure on the government to act fast. Its book **SLOWMURDER**, the deadly story of vehicular pollution in India released by Shri K.R.Narayanan, now the President of India. • Nov 18, 1996, Supreme Court issued suo moto notice to Delhi government, asked for action plan on air pollution. • Dec 1996, the first comprehensive action plan submitted. But no action...

• Nov 1, 1997, CSE organised a public meeting to press for action. • Dec 2, 1997, Ministry of Environment and Forests issued White Paper on pollution in Delhi

• Jan 7,1998 Supreme Court directed government to set up the Environment Pollution (Prevention and Control) Authority, a body to help control pollution.

• July 28, 1998, Supreme Court issued far reaching orders on controlling pollution.

• Nov 1, 1998, CSE put forward a 7-point action agenda. Delhi residents flooded the Prime Minister's office with phone calls asking for action.
